

Population growth, unsustainable management of natural resources as well as increasing amounts of harmful chemicals in the environment lead to severe land degradation.



# Crop Physiology: Drivers of adaptation to change

16 - 21 November 2025

Climate change is a major threat to global food systems. Crop yields are expected to decline due to changes in temperature, water supply and CO2 levels. Moreover, as climate change models have predicted and what we already see today is that conditions will become much more erratic (sudden heat waves, flooding, droughts etc) with dire consequences for plant growth.

# Agroecosystems discussion group


